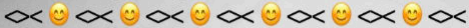

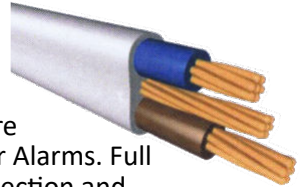

Community Speed Watch Celebrates Its First Year in Action

This month, our village proudly celebrates the first anniversary of Community Speed Watch (CSW) in action - a milestone that reflects a year of dedication, teamwork, and community spirit.

Launched last year under the coordination of Cllr Tracy Gibson-Matthews, and supported by parish councillors Ray Tullock, Jackie North, and Wendy Elliott, CSW has grown into a valued part of village life. Together, they have worked tirelessly to establish and develop the initiative, ensuring it runs smoothly and effectively for the benefit of all residents.

At the heart of CSW's success are the eight resident volunteer operators, whose commitment and enthusiasm have been key. Giving their time and effort, they have helped monitor activity, raise awareness, and support safer practices within the village. Their contribution cannot be overstated - they are a true example of community in action.

Over the past year, CSW has made a noticeable difference. There has been an increase in awareness around road safety, improved communication between neighbours and a stronger sense of people looking out for one another. The

scheme has not only helped address local concerns but has also brought residents closer together.

Like any new initiative, the journey has come with its learning curves. However, thanks to the determination and collaboration of everyone involved, CSW has continued to evolve and strengthen, building a solid foundation for the future.

As CSW moves into its second year, there is plenty to look forward to. With ongoing support from the community, Humberside Police, PCSO and the continued dedication of Cllrs Tracy Gibson-Matthews, Ray Tullock, Jackie North, Wendy Elliott, and the volunteer team, the scheme is well placed to continue making a positive impact.

Special thanks also go to Cllr Ray Tullock for his work on data capture from the Telraam system, which has provided valuable insight to support the initiative, and to Ken Embleton for his continued hard work and commitment to the North Cave Traffic Calming Group. Their contributions have played an important role in strengthening road safety efforts within the village.

This first anniversary is not just a celebration of what has been achieved, but a reminder of what can be accomplished when a community comes together. Thank you to everyone who has



supported CSW so far— here's to another successful year ahead.

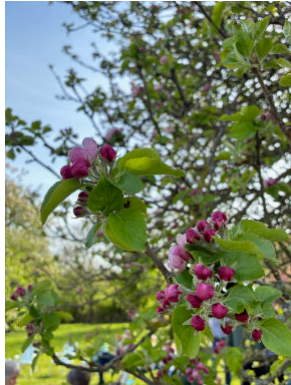


Everthorpe News

Perennials:

Keep on top of watering during dry spells, especially for newly planted varieties. Deadhead faded flowers to encourage more blooms, and support taller plants as they grow.

Herbs:

Harvest regularly to keep plants productive and prevent early flowering. Water little and often, and trim lightly to encourage growth.

Wildflowers:

Let them grow naturally where possible, removing any strong weeds that may take over. Water young plants in very dry weather and enjoy the pollinators they attract.

Our peat-free perennials, herbs, and wildflowers are carefully nurtured by our service users, giving them the chance to learn new skills, build confidence, and be part of a supportive team. Every plant purchase supports the charity, helping us continue to provide meaningful opportunities and a place where people can grow, just like the plants they care for.

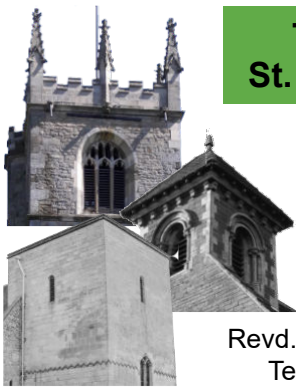

In their first match against Gilberdyke, North Cave produced a strong all-round performance to secure a convincing 71-run win. The second fixture against Middleton & North Dalton proved more competitive, but the team held

their nerve to win by 26 runs.
